We do know the annual State Farm Insurance Yard Sale is happening again in August. Please save items to donate, and plan to shop there. Spread the word! Team 34 has held these events for the past several years. All proceeds go to Amador STARS. The next one is happening in August, date to be determined soon.

There are paint events happening four times a year. If you would like more information on the Sip and Paint Nights, please let us know. There is an upcoming Sip and Paint Event, that was offered to STARS recently. September 16 at Avio Winery, 5 to 8 p.m. Let us know if you are interested in attending this event. <u>Vision Care Chair</u>: Reviews the qualifications required by <u>Lions Eye Foundation</u> and <u>Lions In Sight</u> for individuals who are in need of eye care, eyeglasses or eye surgery. Reviews individuals' form request for eye care financial assistance. Manages Eyeglasses Collection from <u>collection</u> <u>sites</u> and club members. Is also Chairperson for <u>White Cane Days</u> (October time frame)

<u>Steak/Omelet Dinners Chair</u>: In the past, we've usually had an Omelet Dinner in the Spring and Fall – and a Steak Dinner in the summer. Dates are flexible. Lion Larry is retiring from being Omelet Dinner Chair and he can "train" the new chairperson. Lion Ernie has coordinated the Steak Dinners in the past.

<u>Pull Tabs Collections Chair</u>: Promotes/collects <u>Pull Tabs for Ronald McDonald House</u>. Weighs/packages pull tabs to be delivered to District Meetings or to our Zone Chair.

<u>Student Speakers Contest Chair</u>: Receives <u>contest</u> information from District 4-A1 and MD4 (State). Reviews the contest rules. Sets up time and place for contest.

Coordinates information with Amador County's school staff and teachers. Finds and communicates with non-Lions to be judges (community-area individuals).

Communicates with each student via phone or email to keep them informed. Day of contest - prepared and ready to emcee the contest. (February time frame)

Angel Tree Holiday Project Chair: Coordinates with Amador County's Angel Tree Program to get names/ages of children in need for Christmas Gifts, especially here in upcountry. Informs & coordinates with club members to get gifts for the children. (November/December time frame).




