

MOUNTAIN ZONE MEETING UPDATE

On August 29th, Lion President Gail and Lion Secretary Brian represented Up Country 88 Lions at the Mountain Zone Meeting in Burson, CA at the Tri-Dams Lions' Clubhouse/Community Building.


The meeting was focused on discussion about Lions' Club Excellence Award and Service Projects. District Governor Claudia Miller (who is currently our acting Zone Chair) explained that California Cares is challenging clubs to increase participation in Service Projects. She shared information about two projects that have drawn interest and were hands-on at the last District Meeting:

Donating or selling "No Spark" Chain Covers and "Magic Yarn" head coverings for kids with cancer.

The clubs attending discussed other ideas – such as trash pick-ups, school reading programs, disaster preparedness, Easter Egg Hunts, training dogs to recognize rattle snakes, how to protect seniors' vision, etc.

There were lots of good ideas for projects a club like ours could do that doesn't require a lot of expense or effort. There were also short discussions about the Youth Protection Policy (if we should have help from youth in our future projects), District 4-A1 help for Meet & Greet events, and Lions International's initiatives on Diabetes, Vision, Childhood Cancer, Hunger, and Environment. ~ Lion Brian




